### Abbreviations used for status and category

#### Status:

- B regular breeding species in Austria
- D occurs in Austria only on migration
- S occurs in Austria only as a non-breeding summer visitor
- W occurs on Austria only as winter guest
- eB former regular breeding species, now extinct
- /b has bred in Austria only once or irregularly
- U irregular visitor in Austria (at least 15 records in Austria; recorded during the last 20 years in less than 15 years but more than 5 times)
- A vagrant (either less than 15 records in total or a maximum of 5 records during the last 20 years irrespective of the total number of records)

**Category:**

- A Recorded in Austria at least once in a wild state since 1. January 1950. There is or was a proof for at least one record (specimen, photograph, video, sound recording etc.).
- A<sub>0</sub> No proof (specimen, photograph, video, sound recording etc.) but at least one report since 1950 was accepted by the Austrian Avifaunistic Committee as sufficiently documented.
- B Recorded in a wild state in Austria only between 1800 and 31. December 1949. There is or was a proof for at least one record.
- B<sub>0</sub> Recorded in a wild state in Austria only between 1800 and 31. December 1949, but there is or was no proof for these records.
- C Established in Austria as self-sustaining breeding species by man. This includes species that have never been autochthonous to Austria (C<sub>1</sub>), species that also occur in Austria in a wild state (C<sub>2</sub>), extinct species that have been reintroduced successfully (C<sub>3</sub>) and domesticated species that have established self-sustaining feral populations in Austria (C<sub>4</sub>).

Additionally this category includes species for which there are records of birds that originate from only possibly self-sustaining populations in other countries (D<sub>4</sub>).
